Antler Competition

Antlers may be entered into competition on Saturday, March 18, 2023, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. only.

The categories will be as follows:

* Yearling typical

* 2 year typical

* 3 year typical

* Adult typical

* Yearling non-typical

* 2 year non-typical

* 3 year non-typical

* Adult non-typical

* **Best in Show (voted on)**

Antlers must be from bucks whose antlers were cut or shed in 2022/2023 and not entered in any previous WOW antler competition. There is a \$20 charge for each pair of antlers entered; no antlers may be left at the table until the entry fee has been received. The SCI scoring system will be employed; two official SCI scorers will be the ones doing the scoring. Antlers must have less than 10% non-typical to be classified in the typical category. A "Best in Show" award will be presented, based on membership votes.

Troy Borge from ADM Animal Nutrition has volunteered to donate the plaques for the winners of the antler competition. These plaques are pre-printed, so it is important to fill each category. Please bring in your sheds for competition! **Antlers must be entered before 10:30 a.m. on March 18, 2023.** ("Best of Show" Voting closes at 3:15 p.m.)
