

2023 Antler Scoring Criteria

The Categories are: Typical and Non-Typical

- Yearling
- 2 year old
- 3 year old
- Mature

- Antlers must be from bucks whose antlers were cut or shed in 2022/2023 and not entered in any previous WOW antler competition.
- Can use the buck's inside spread as long as a picture is provided.
- 2% deduction for velvet scores.
- No replicas.
- Broken tines can be included in the total score provided they are included with antlers.
- Repairs should be noted on the entry form.
- Scores of winning antlers will be published in the WOW newsletter.
- There is a \$20 charge for each set of antlers entered.
- Any antlers submitted to the antler contest, if their farm is quarantined, need to follow the quarantine order.
- Cut- off antlers will receive additional inches as follows:
 - 1" for yearling
 - 1.5" for 2 year old
 - 2" for 3 year old and Mature

The SCI scoring system will be used to score the antlers. However, in challenging the decision of measuring/scoring will be based on the rational of the committee. Antlers must have less than 10% non-typical points to be classified in the typical category.

The following information will be needed:

- Name of the buck
- Name of the owner
- Tag # of the deer
- Farm name
- Buck's age
- Note of any repairs
- Your signature that verifies:
